## REQUIREMENTS

1. An applicant's parent or legal guardian must be a member of a Local Union affiliated with the Hudson County Central Labor Council AFL-CIO.
2. All requirements must be met and all information submitted for the application to be considered.
3. Each applicant must include their **MOST RECENT** transcript from the institution in which they are **CURRENTLY** enrolled. All applicants **MUST** submit **COMPLETE** copies of their official transcripts. If you are already in college, you **MUST** submit your college transcripts as well any other transcripts you think document your academic achievement.
4. Each application must be accompanied with a short essay of 500 words or less describing your connection with the union and the labor movement.
5. A letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor/teacher **MUST** be included with all applications.
6. Include any Community Service or extracurricular activities.
7. The recipients must be enrolled at an accredited college, nursing school or technical school.
8. The scholarships will be available to full and part-time students.
9. The scholarships will be granted to students for a period of one academic year. You may reapply for a scholarship every year but no more than the first four years.
10. Twelve scholarships will be awarded:
  - a. Two scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be awarded for merit which will be based on scholastic achievement for the Edward B. Pulver Scholarship and two for the Donna Benjamin Scholarship for Health Care Professionals.
  - b. Two scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be awarded to a student that shows evidence of significant achievement for the Edward B. Pulver Scholarship and two for the Donna Benjamin Scholarship for Health Care Professionals.
  - c. Two scholarships of \$1,000.00 will be awarded to a special needs student for the Edward B. Pulver Scholarship and two for the Donna Benjamin Scholarship for Health Care Professionals. Proof of eligibility

must be provided by the applicant, child study team or a guidance counselor.

11. An independent third party will review all applications.
